## POPULATION AND VITAL STATISTICS DECEMBER 2014

The population of Seychelles stood at 92,126 at December 2014, indicating a growth rate of 1.2% over 2013. A total of 1,557 births and 725 deaths were recorded. Of the 725 deaths, 17 were infant deaths and the infant mortality rate stood at 10.9 per thousand live births compared to 18.5 in 2013. The total fertility rate stands at 2.3 and the life expectancy is 73 years.
