### POPULATION AND VITAL STATISTICS

#### DECEMBER 2021

The population of Seychelles stood at 99,728 at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021, indicating a growth rate of 0.8% over 2020. A total of 1,665 births and 925 deaths were registered. Of the 925 deaths, 18 were infant deaths and the infant mortality rate stood at 10.8 per thousand live births compared to 11.6 in 2020. The total fertility rate stands at 2.5 and the life expectancy for both sexes is 74 years.
